EASTER – THE FEAST OF THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST FROM THE DEAD

Easter Sunday is the greatest of all Sundays. Easter Time is the most important of all liturgical times. Easter is the celebration of the Lord's resurrection from the dead, culminating in his Ascension to the Father and sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. All faith flows from faith in the Resurrection of Jesus: "If Christ has not been raised, then empty is our preaching; empty, too, is your faith." (1 Cor 15:14) Just as Christ has been raised from the dead, so too will all those who believe in Him share eternal life.

There are fifty days of Easter from April 1st to the first Sunday to Pentecost, June 20th. This liturgical time is characterized by the joy of glorified life and the victory over death, expressed most fully in the great resounding cry of the Christian: **ALLELUIA! ALLELUIA!**

The word "Easter" comes from Old English, meaning simply the "East." The sun which rises in the East, bringing light, warmth and hope, is a symbol for the Christian of the rising Christ, who is the true Light of the world. The Paschal Candle is a central symbol of this divine light, which is Christ, and is lit for all liturgical celebrations during the Easter Time. As Christians, baptized in Christ, each one of us is called to be a Light of Christ. **REJOICE!**
