**THE SOLEMNITY OF ST. JOSEPH, SPOUSE OF MARY -
MARCH 19, 2018**

The Bible says very little about St. Joseph except that he was a
"righteous man." That speaks volumes! It means that Joseph
had set his heart on seeking God and doing His will. He surely
focused his life on the two great commandments--"Love the Lord
your God "and "Love your neighbor as yourself."

St. Joseph had "dreams" in which he heard, "Do not be
afraid!" He was willing to follow God's plans, whether to take
pregnant Mary as his wife, to travel to register in Bethlehem, to
take the Child Jesus and His Mother to Egypt, to return to live in
Nazareth, and even while young, to face death and leave Jesus
and Mary on earth. Here is a powerful prayer to good St.
Joseph:

*Oh, St. Joseph, whose protection is so great, so strong, so
prompt before the throne of God, I place in you all my
interest and desires. Oh, St. Joseph, do assist me by your
powerful intercession, and obtain for me from your divine
Son all spiritual blessings through Jesus Christ, our Lord,
so that having engaged here below your heavenly power, I
may offer my thanksgiving and homage to the most loving
of Fathers.*

*Oh, St. Joseph, I never weary contemplating you and Jesus
asleep in your arms. I dare not approach while He reposes
near your heart. Press Him in my name and kiss His fine
head for me and ask Him to return the Kiss when I draw my
dying breath. St. Joseph, Patron of departing souls, pray
for me.*
