SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER, SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION, MOTHER'S DAY, FEAST OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA
MULTIPLE REASONS TO CELEBRATE THIS DAY, MAY 13, 2018!

MAY 13TH IS SIGNIFICANT!

On **May 13, 1917**, a Russian army stormed into the Moscow churches to wipe out the Christians worshipping God. That was the beginning of atheistic Communism that eventually dominated so many countries in Europe and Asia in the past century.

On **May 13, 1917**, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to little children, Lucy, Jacinta, and Francisco at Fatima, Portugal to tell them to pray the Rosary for world peace and the conversion of sinners. She warned that Russia would spread its errors over the world, and asked that Russia be consecrated to her Immaculate Heart.

On **May 13, 1981**- In St. Peter's Square in the Vatican, St. Pope John Paul II was wounded with four rounds of shot by a Turkish sniper, Mehmet Ali Agca. The assassination attempt was carried out under orders from Islamic terrorists.

On **May 13, 1982** - **St. Pope John Paul II** made a pilgrimage to Fatima to leave the bullets that almost killed him, and to thank the Blessed Mother, as well as to consecrate the world to her Immaculate Heart. In his homily, he reminded all of the *spiritual motherhood of Mary*.

Motherhood means caring for the life of the child. The care of a mother embraces her child totally. Mary's motherhood has its beginning in her motherly care for Christ. In Christ, at the foot of the Cross, she accepted John, and in John she *accepted all of us totally*. Mary embraces us all with special solicitude in the *Holy Spirit*. For as we profess in our *Creed*, He is "the giver of life". Mary's spiritual motherhood is therefore a *sharing* in the *power of the Holy Spirit*, of "the giver of life". It is the humble service of her who says of herself: "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord" (Lk 1:38). In the light of the mystery of Mary's spiritual motherhood, let us seek to understand the *extraordinary message*, which began on 13 May, 1917 to resound throughout the world from Fátima, continuing for five months until 13 October of the same year."
