15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

It is frustrating to believe that you are right while no one seems to listen. A parent can patiently point out the right direction to a teenage child who is yearning to break the yoke of blind obedience. The teen is still likely to take the wrong turn. Watching a friend make life-changing decisions can lead to misery and ruin, you will find it impossible not to get involved and to offer advice. The warned friend will often stubbornly push ahead in the ruinous direction, showing only resentment for you and your cautionary message.

“Don't listen to me, then: you deserve whatever you get,” you mutter angrily under your breath.

That is not the message that Jesus imparts to the apostles or to us as he sends us on our mission to spread the good word. You are unlikely to tell all that they should repent, cast out their demons, anoint and cure them, but the task that Jesus assigns us is not that different than his direction to the apostles.

Live simply and share the message of salvation as best you can. When that message falls on deaf ears, do not become irate and make a scene that will harden the hearts of those who refuse to listen. Shake the dust off your feet and leave the path open to try again. Frank Campbell, Enfield, NS
