**TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

What would you do if you knew that you had only twenty-four  
hours to live?

In St. Paul's Letter to the Ephesians today, we hear his  
advice: "Be careful how you live, not as unwise people but as  
wise, making most of the time. . .do not be foolish, but  
understand what is the will of the Lord." The Book of Proverbs  
cautions: "Lay aside immaturity, and live and walk in the way  
of insight."

How much time do we have to turn away from evil and to do  
good? Only God knows!

There is the story of the doctor reporting to his patient about  
recent medical tests. He began with the message: "I have  
some bad news and worse news to tell you. Which one do you  
want to hear first?" The man said, "I'll take the bad news  
first" to which the doctor replied, "The bad news is that you  
only have twenty-four hours to live." At this the man jumped up  
and cried loudly, "Twenty-four hours to live? I can't believe this.  
There is no time to complete all of what I want do." Then he  
asked the doctor, "What could be worse news than this?" The  
doctor answered, "The worse news is that I was supposed to  
tell you this yesterday."

What would you do if you knew that you had only twenty-four  
hours to live?

**REMEMBER** it is never too late to pray for God's mercy and  
put your life in order to be ready to meet your Judge. Today's  
Gospel assures us, "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my  
blood has eternal life and I will raise him up on the last day."

9. *You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.*
10. *You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.*

JESUS SUMMED UP THE DECALOGUE: "You shall love the  
Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and  
with all your mind. This is the greatest and first commandment  
and the second is like to this, "You shall love your neighbor as  
yourself." **Love does no wrong to a neighbor.**
