FEAST OF ST. THOMAS AQUINAS
JANUARY 28, 2019

St. Thomas Aquinas (1224-1274), brilliant philosopher and theologian, was a humble Dominican friar who was nicknamed "The Dumb Ox" by his classmates. Yet, his life of prayer and communion with God, his deep devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, enabled him to write the *SUMMA THEOLOGICA*, used by the Church in education of theologians up to this day. St Thomas Aquinas also composed the Benediction hymns: *Tantum Ergo; Pange Linqua, and Adorate Devote*. His prayer before Holy Communion reveals his humility and love.

Almighty and Eternal God, behold I come to the sacrament of Your only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ. As one sick I come to the Physician of life; unclean, to the Fountain of mercy; blind, to the Light of eternal splendor; poor and needy to the Lord of heaven and earth. Therefore, I beg of You, through Your infinite mercy and generosity, heal my weakness, wash my uncleanness, give light to my blindness, enrich my poverty, and clothe my nakedness. May I thus receive the Bread of Angels, the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords, with such reverence and humility, contrition and devotion, purity and faith, purpose and intention, as shall aid my soul's salvation. Grant, I beg of You, that I may receive not only the Sacrament of the Body and Blood of our Lord, but also its full grace and power. Give me the grace, most merciful God, to receive the Body of your only Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, born of the Virgin Mary, in such a manner that I may deserve to be intimately united with His mystical Body and to be numbered among His members. Most loving Father, grant that I may behold for all eternity face to face Your beloved Son, whom now, on my pilgrimage, I am about to receive under the sacramental veil, who lives and reigns with You, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, world without end. Amen.

FEAST OF ST. JOHN BOSCO, FATHER AND TEACHER OF YOUTH, JANUARY 31, 2019

Don Bosco (1815-1888) was raised in a poor family in Piedmont, Italy. After his ordination to the priesthood in 1841, he witnessed the terrible conditions of youth in prisons and resolved to help juvenile delinquents. He formed the Salesian Society named after gentle St. Francis de Sales to help boys with their faith formation and to stay out of trouble. At his canonization in 1934, St. John Bosco was given the title, "Father and Teacher of Youth" by Pope Pius XI. In 2001, Pope John Paul II was petitioned to declare St. John Bosco "Patron of Stage Magicians" because that holy priest pioneered the art of what is today called "Gospel Magic", using magic and other feats to attract attention of the youth to Christ. The Salesian Priests and Sisters now minister to needy children all over the world.
