**SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT**

Today's first reading is one of the most important religious texts ever written. While it is strange for us to read of a god asking for human sacrifice, that was nothing out of the ordinary in Abraham's world. The bewilderment we feel reading this passage is, in fact, a result of the text's own success. It is because of the story of Abraham and Isaac that human and child sacrifice looks the way it does to us. Human sacrifice is not some aberration in human history. In one way or another, it is the norm. The other gods humans have worshipped, whether they go by ancient names like Baal and Motech, or modern names like Choice and National Security, have always demanded what is most precious, our sons and daughters. It is only the God of Abraham who does not demand but provides the sacrifice. The story of Abraham and Isaac begins the trajectory that ends with Christ. When Paul tells the Romans that God "did not withhold his own Son," he is linking Jesus and Isaac and pointing us towards the inversion of sacrifice that Isaac presaged and Jesus fulfilled. This inversion transfigures human history. What could this rising from the dead mean? That one who gave himself to be sacrificed so that we might see the truth about human sacrifice was God's own Son.

**ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP:** 'Fast from Food Waste' is suggested as a Lenten practice by Ignatian Solidarity Network. Approximately 1/3 of food produced is wasted across the global food supply chain in one year. Around 40% is wasted in the United States annually. (Yale Climate Connections) As a result of the 1.3 billion tons of food wasted every year worldwide, 45 trillion gallons of water are also wasted. When we throw food in the trash, we're throwing away all of the resources that went into growing, harvesting, packaging, and shipping the food such as water, gasoline, land, and pesticides.(NPR) "...'whenever food is thrown out it is as if it were stolen from the table of the poor.'" -- Laudato Si' So food waste is an issue within our control. We have the power to avoid food waste three times a day.
