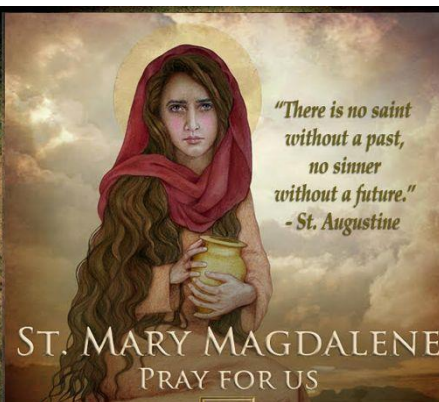


FEAST DAY OF ST. KATERI TEKAKWITHA.

On July 14, the Church celebrates the feast day of St. Kateri Tekakwitha, the first Native American to be canonized. Known as the "Lily of the Mohawks," Judging that she was ready, Lamberville baptized Tekakwitha at the age of 19, on Easter Sunday, April 18, 1676. Tekakwitha

was renamed "Catherine" after St. Catherine of Siena (Kateri was the Mohawk form of the name). Kateri lived a life of holiness and virtue, despite obstacles and opposition within her tribe. The Roman Catholic Church has honored Kateri Tekakwitha for her devotion to Christ and her commitment to charity and chastity. *Pray for us O holy daughter of the Mother of God, that we may find Christ through you, St. Kateri Tekakwitha. Lead us on the road to heaven without ever abandoning us, through your eternal spouse, Jesus Christ. Amen.*

FEAST OF ST. MARY MAGDALENE JULY 22:

St. Mary Magdalene is the patron saint of perfumers. She was present at Christ's Crucifixion and burial. She is also associated with the sinful woman who repented and anointed Christ's feet with perfumed oil (Luke 7:36-9). The Gospel of Luke chapter 8 lists Mary Magdalene as one of the women who traveled

with Jesus and helped support his ministry. The same passage also states that seven demons had been driven out of her, a statement which is repeated from Mark 16. Mary Magdalene is especially significant as the first witness to see Jesus following the resurrection. In a time when women were regarded as second-class citizens, God gave Mary – a woman – a highly significant honor by appearing to her first and charging her to spread the good news of his resurrection.
